

Supporting documents checklist

The below documents have to be submitted in each case, upon availability. Mandatory documents are marked with a star (*). For the starred documents, in case the document is not available, an explanation has to be attached.

- 1) Passport/travel document (even expired), visas and the entry stamp to country of asylum/residence *
- 2) Other documents pertaining to legal registration with the government and/or UNHCR of the country of current residence *
- 3) National IDs *
- 4) Marriage and birth certificates *
- 5) UNHCR registration/recognition documents *
- **6)** One photo from each family members taken in the past 6 months per this link *
- 7) Custody or statutory declaration for adopted children/relatives *
- **8)** Work documents (contracts, ID cards, letters of reference)
- **9)** Education documents (higher education certificates only)
- **10)** Documents pertaining to the experienced threats and protection risks (Police reports, news articles, hospital records, doctor's notes, warning letters, etc)

Please note that:

All documents have to be scanned with a quality of 400 DPI or higher.

Documents (other than IDs) are accepted only in French or English. If you need support with translating your documents, please inform your Case Worker.

If you are found eligible and you don't have a passport/travel document, your request will be screened and handled on a case by case basis. PD.eu cannot commit to obtaining travel documents/passports for applicants at this stage.

Any manipulation in the documents or faking a document will amount to misrepresentation which could affect or delay the processing of your case.
